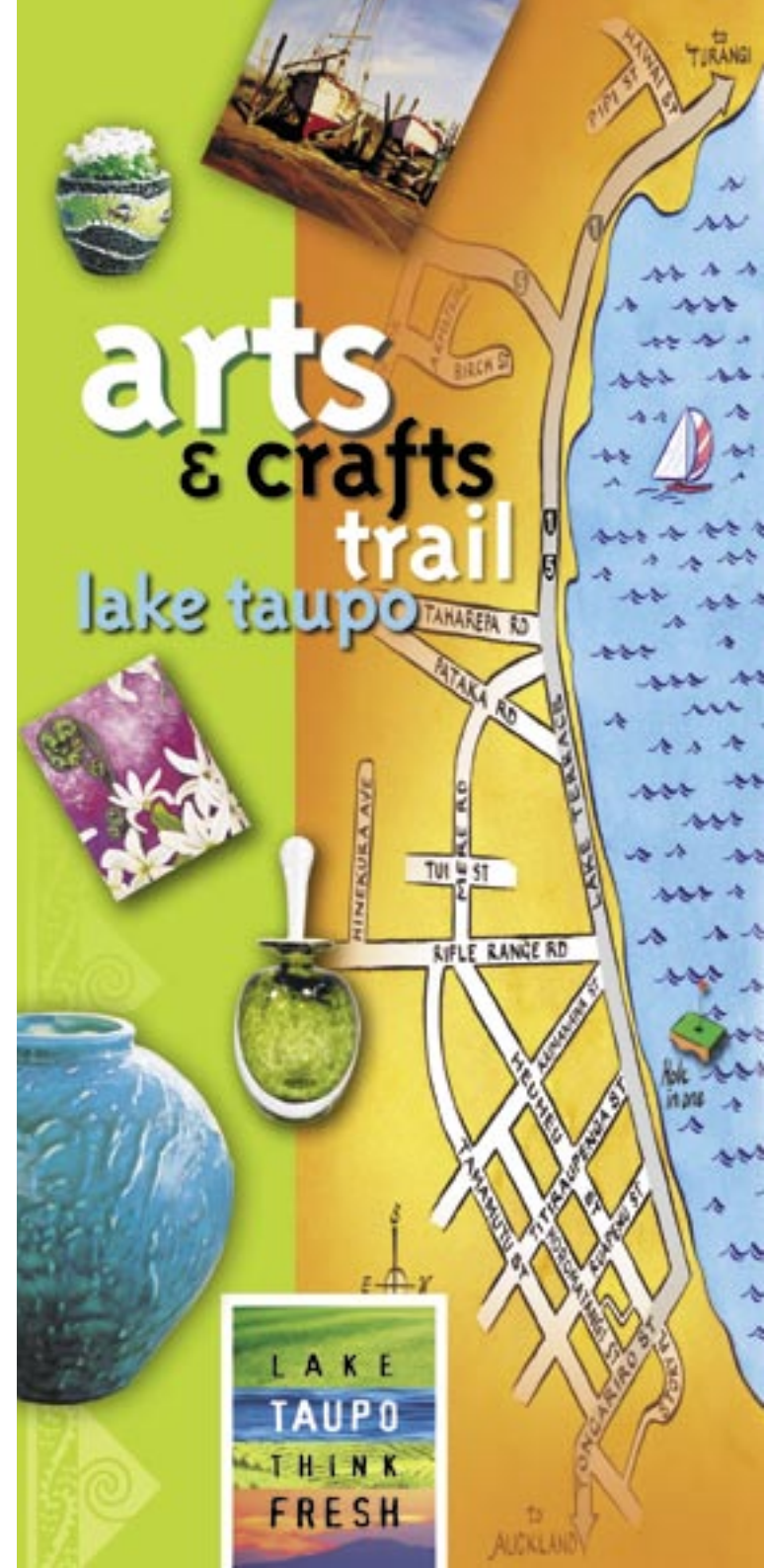

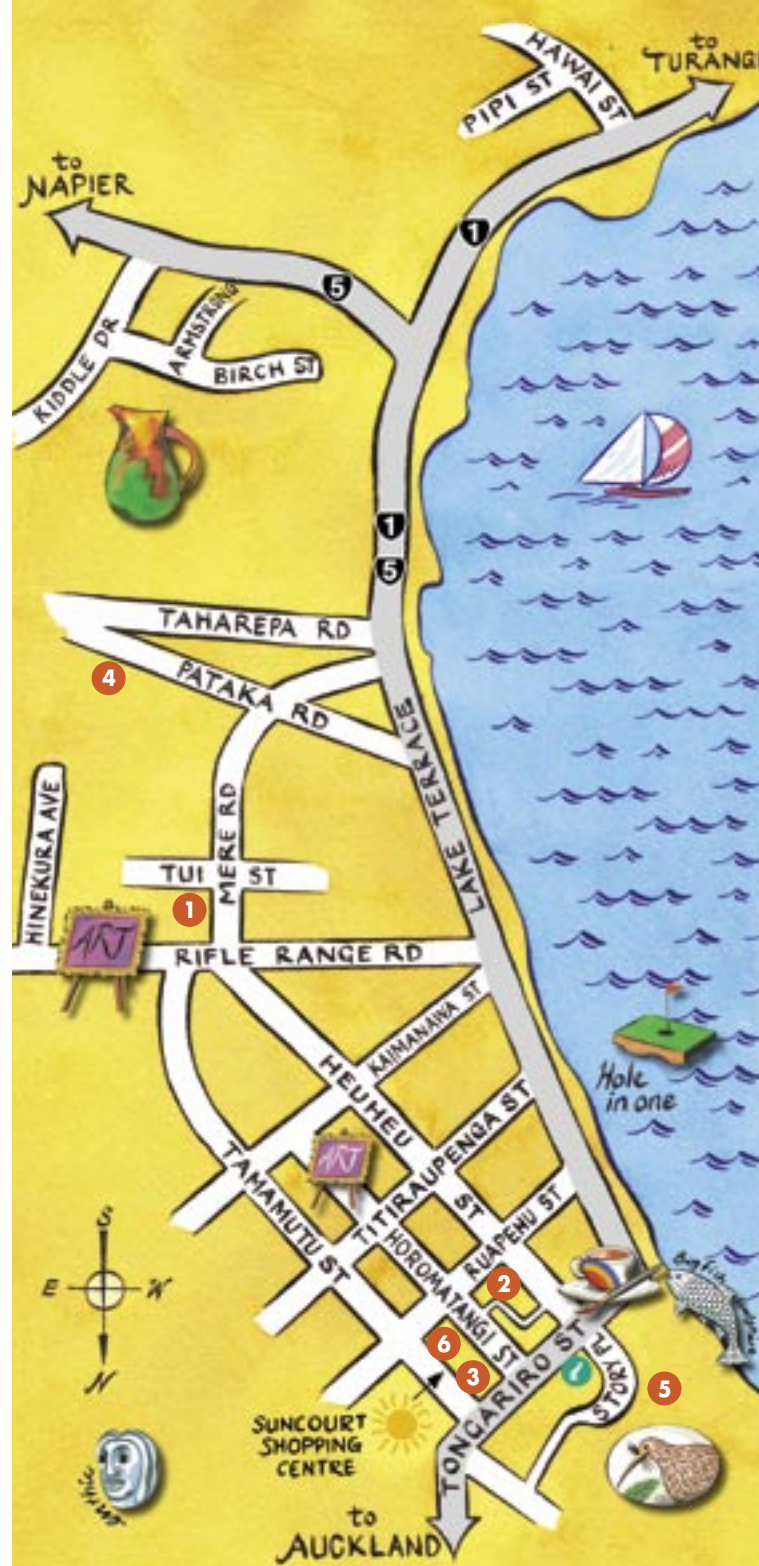


4 The Mallards Studio/Gallery
